Reviewing Eagle Candidate Documents

Step One inventory documents

- Project workbook with ALL signatures?
- most current Eagle Application with 3 signatures ?
- Member Unit Advancement Summary? (MUAS)
- statement of ambitions and accomplishments?

Step Two – Eagle Project Workbook Review

- All questions answered, including project coach comments
- Work done date is after approval signatures (beneficiary, troop, district)
- Major scope change?
- check hours for planning, counting, and 2-deep leadership
- Excess funds should have been turned over to the beneficiary.

Step Three – Eagle Application Review

- Name needs to agree with MUAS or candidate is OK with MUAS name
- complete address, troop number, city, state, zip?
- check MUAS for date became a Scout...Scout rank date or earlier
- 1st Class BOR date agrees with MUAS
- Star BOR date agrees with MUAS
- 4 questions answered...one needs to be yes
- confirm that DOB allows for Eagle rank.
- Life BOR agrees with MUAS and insertion on page 2 of application
- Life Scout BOR permits 6 months of active time in troop
- References completely filled in
- Unit number must be filled in for all merit badges
- If the Scout has more than one unit, make sure unit numbers are correct
- All merit badge names spelled correctly
- No merit badge dates are prior to the date he joined Scouting
- 4 Eagle and 2 non-Eagle badges for Star
- 4 months from 1st Class to Star and 6 months from Star to Life
- 7 Eagle and 4 non-Eagle for Life
- Position of leadership is a valid Eagle position and has 6 months after Life BOR
- End date of position should be either the date he signs the application or earlier
- Grand total hours should agree with the project workbook
- Review statement of ambitions and accomplishments
- Date of SM conference is earlier or the same as the Scout's signature
- All signatures are AFTER all requirements are complete
